## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

<u>Subject</u>: Compulsory mid-career training programme of the Indian Economic Service to be conducted by the Indian Institute of Management, Lucknow from 8<sup>th</sup> September –18<sup>th</sup> October, 2014

- 3. It is mentioned that the mid-career training program comes with a lot of effort on our part as well as cost to the Government. It also entails advance planning in terms of tying up with foreign/domestic partner institutions and faculty resources, apart from handling the logistics connected to foreign visits etc. Hence, it is requested that the nominated officers may be relieved in time so as to avoid last minute cancellations which would cause loss to the Government exchequer and raise audit objections.
